Objective

The objective of this lesson is for the student to improve their English skills by talking about their favorite cartoon character.

Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Colored pencils or crayons
- Any drawings or pictures of the student's favorite cartoon character

Before starting the lesson, make sure the student has a basic understanding of English vocabulary related to cartoons and their favorite character.

Activities
