Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to create diorama houses for figures based on different designs.

Materials and Prep

- Cardboard or shoeboxes
- Scissors
- Glue
- Markers or colored pencils
- Construction paper
- Figurines or small toys
- Magazines or printed images for inspiration

No prior knowledge or preparation is required for this lesson.

Activities

- 1. Brainstorming: Encourage the student to think of different types of houses or environments they would like to create for their figures. They can draw or write down their ideas.
- 2. Design and Cut: Using the cardboard or shoeboxes, guide the student to cut out walls, floors, and a roof for their diorama house. They can create multiple rooms or levels if desired.
