## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to learn about monkeys and their characteristics.

## **Materials and Prep**

- Books or pictures of monkeys
- Coloring materials
- Whiteboard or paper

## Activities

- Monkey Coloring: Show the student pictures of different monkeys and let them choose one to color. Encourage them to use different colors and be creative.
- Monkey Movement: Ask the student to imitate different monkey movements such as swinging from trees, hopping, or walking on all fours.
- Monkey Sounds: Play recordings of monkey sounds and ask the student to mimic them. Discuss the different sounds monkeys make and what they might mean.
- Monkey Facts: Read a book or show pictures of monkeys while discussing interesting facts about them, such as where they live, what they eat, and how they communicate.
