- 4. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
- 5. Honor your father and your mother.
- 6. You shall not murder.
- 7. You shall not commit adultery.
- 8. You shall not steal.
- 9. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 10. You shall not covet.

2.	How can you practice the first commandment in your daily life?			
3.	Reflect on the fourth commandment: What activities do you think would help you keep the Sabbath day holy?			
4.	Explain a situation where you think the sixth commandment (You shall not murder) applies, not just in its literal sense but in a broader context.			
5.	Consider the tenth commandment: What are some ways you can avoid feeling envious of others?
