2. The \_\_\_\_\_ (adjective) cake smelled \_\_\_\_\_ (verb) in the oven.



Begin a short story with this sentence: "As I opened the door, I found myself in a world where..." Use at least four verbs and three adjectives to bring your story to life!


### 5. Draw and Write
