2. **Donkey** → J. Brays
3. **Frog** → K. Croaks
4. **Peacock** → (Screams - No letter provided, but this is the correct sound)
5. **Duck** → I. Quacks
6. **Dog** → H. Barks
7. **Rat** → D. Squeaks
8. **Tiger** → B. Roars
9. **Bee** → G. Buzzes
10. **Bird** → F. Tweets
11. **Wolf** → A. Howls
12. **Sheep** → C. Bleats

Note: The sound a peacock makes is often called a "scream." There was no letter for this match.
