Physical Education

The Glass Bridge game required incredible balance and precision. Let's practice your balance safely!

- 1. Find a line on the floor (like a floorboard or tile line) or place a rope or piece of tape in a straight line on the floor.
- 2. Walk the entire length of the line, heel-to-toe, without stepping off.
- 3. **Challenge:** Once you master walking forward, try walking the line backward!
- 4. **Expert Mode:** Try walking the line with your eyes closed. (Make sure your area is clear of obstacles first!)

Science

Making Dalgona candy, the honeycomb challenge, involves a simple but interesting chemical reaction. When sugar is heated, it caramelizes. Then, a tiny amount of baking soda (sodium bicarbonate) is added. The heat causes the baking soda to decompose and release a gas, which gets trapped in the sticky sugar, making it light and brittle. What is the name of the gas that the baking soda releases?

Social Studies

In the Tug-of-War game, Player 001's strategy helped his team win against a stronger team. He argued that teamwork, strategy, and timing were more important than just pure strength. Besides Tug-of-War, describe another situation (from real life, sports, or school) where good teamwork can overcome a bigger challenge.

Answer Key

Art: Answers will vary. Look for a creative design and a thoughtful explanation connecting the symbol to a role or idea.

English: Answers will vary. Paragraphs should describe qualities like loyalty, trust, honesty, kindness, and being supportive.

Foreign Language (Korean): 1-C, 2-D, 3-A, 4-B

History: Answers will vary. Examples include: The Philippines (Pepsi, 7-Up), The UK (Statues), France (Un, deux, trois, soleil), USA (Freeze Dance).

Math:

Music: Answers will vary but should touch on the idea of **irony** or creating a creepy, unsettling, or surreal feeling. The contrast between the happy music and the scary visuals makes the scene more disturbing.

Science: Carbon Dioxide (or CO2).

Social Studies: Answers will vary widely. Examples could include: a group science project where different people do research, experiments, and writing; a basketball team using clever plays to beat a team with taller players; a community organizing a fundraiser to achieve a large financial goal.
