Since many of the questions are based on your personal reading experience and creativity, there are no single "right" answers. Use this guide to see if you are on the right track.

English Section Guidance

- **Part 1 & 2 (Basics & Summary):** Your summary should accurately mention the main characters involved, the central problem they faced (like a specific Upper Rank demon), and how the volume ended. Check that you remembered the key events in the correct order.
- **Part 3 (Vocabulary Builder):** A good answer will correctly define the word and use it properly in a new, original sentence.
Example: If you chose the word "resilience"...
Definition: *The capacity to recover quickly from difficulties; toughness.*
Your Sentence: *Tanjiro's resilience was tested during his harsh training.*
- **Part 4 (My Review):** A strong review gives specific reasons for your opinions. Instead of just "I liked the fight," try "I liked the fight between Tengen and Gyutaro because the art showed their incredible speed and power."

Art Section Guidance

- **Part 1 (Onomatopoeia):** Your drawings of the sound words should be dynamic. For a word like "CRACKLE," you might use jagged, electric-looking letters. For "SLICE," the letters could look sharp and cut-through. The art should match the sound.
- **Part 2 (Breathing Style):** Your new style should be creative and consistent. If you created "Breath of Echoes," the First Form might be named "Ringing Slash," and the visual effect could be drawn as concentric circles or sound waves.
- **Part 3 (Redraw a Panel):** This is all about your personal expression! The goal is to capture the feeling of the original scene while using your own drawing style. There is no wrong way to do this as long as you've put in the creative effort.
