Different Forms of Government

Governments can be classified into various forms based on how power is distributed and who holds it. Here are some common forms:

- **Democracy:** In a democracy, the power lies with the people. Citizens have the right to vote to elect their leaders and influence policies.
- **Monarchy:** A monarchy is a form of government where a single ruler, usually a king or queen, holds power. Monarchies can be absolute or constitutional.
- **Oligarchy:** An oligarchy is a form of government where a small group of people have control. This group may be distinguished by wealth, family ties, or military power.
- **Tyranny:** Tyranny occurs when a single ruler holds absolute power, often obtained by force, and usually rules in a cruel or oppressive manner.
- **Theocracy:** In a theocracy, religious leaders control the government, and policies are often based on religious laws.
- **Communism:** In a communist system, the government owns all property and means of production, aiming for a classless society.
